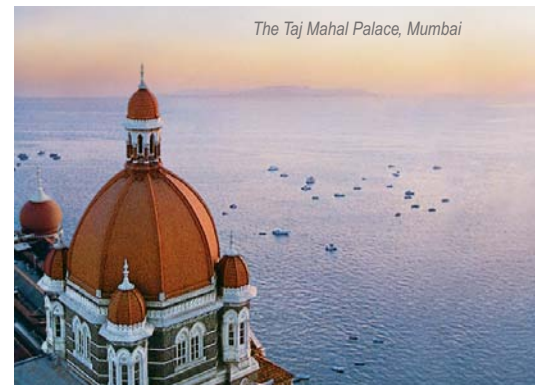

Thimphu, Bhutan

The Kingdom of Bhutan - long considered the mountain fortress of the gods - is an ancient kingdom secluded high in the Himalayas with unique customs and people with deeply-held beliefs. Thimphu, the charming capital, rests in the heart of the Himalayas, 7500 feet above sea level, overlooking the Wang Chu river valley.

Taj Tashi, Thimphu, situated in the centre of the capital city, has adopted age-old Bhutanese traditions in its architecture. A short walk away from the golf course, the hotel offers panoramic views of neighbouring mountains.

### Accessibility

Bhutan is accessible by air from Delhi, Kolkata, Kathmandu, Bangkok and Dhaka. The international airport, situated at Paro is 65 km away from Thimphu. Bhutan can also be accessed by road from Phuntsholing, which adjoins the Dooars region of India.
